HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

FOR SUSPENSION OF THE JOINT RULES OF THE HOUSE OF
REPRESENTATIVES AND THE SENATE TO PERMIT THE INTRODUCTION AND
CONSIDERATION OF A HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION REQUESTING A
STUDY BE CONDUCTED REGARDING THE DESIRABILITY AND FEASIBILITY
OF ESTABLISHING A REVOLVING LOAN FUND TO BE MADE AVAILABLE TO
CITIES AND COUNTIES FOR THE EXCLUSIVE PURPOSE OF CONSTRUCTING
SPECULATIVE BUILDINGS TO ATTRACT INDUSTRY.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE SEVENTY-SIXTH
GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE SENATE CONCURRING
THEREIN:

That the Joint Rules of the House of Representatives and Senate
are hereby suspended for the purpose of permitting the introduction
and consideration of a House Concurrent Resolution requesting a
study be conducted regarding the desirability and feasibility of
establishing a revolving loan fund to be made available to cities
and counties for the exclusive purpose of constructing speculative
buildings to attract industry.
