

HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

TO SUSPEND THE JOINT RULES OF THE HOUSE AND THE SENATE
TO ALLOW REPRESENTATIVES GILBERT AND MCCOY TO INTRODUCE
A HOUSE RESOLUTION TO AMEND THE RULES OF THE HOUSE TO
PROHIBIT THE INTRODUCTION OR CONSIDERATION OF ANY BILL
WHICH WOULD ESTABLISH GROUNDS FOR THE REVOCATION OR SUS-
PENSION OF HEALTH CARE PROVIDER LICENSES OR ESTABLISH
CONDITIONS FOR THE ISSUANCE OR RENEWAL OF HEALTH CARE
PROVIDER LICENSES UNLESS THE BILL HAS FIRST BEEN REVIEWED
BY AN INTERIM COMMITTEE OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE SEVENTY-SIXTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY FOR THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

That the Joint Rules of the House and Senate are hereby amended to allow Representatives Gilbert and McCoy to introduce a House Resolution to amend the rules of the House to prohibit the introduction or consideration of any bill which would establish grounds for the revocation or suspension of health care provider licenses or establish conditions for the issuance or renewal of health care provider licenses unless the bill has first been reviewed by a interim committee of the General Assembly.
