

HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

TO SUSPEND THE JOINT RULES OF THE HOUSE AND THE SENATE TO ALLOW REPRESENTATIVES BLAIR, THICKSTEN AND POLLAN TO INTRODUCE A HOUSE RESOLUTION TO REQUEST THAT THE JOINT INTERIM COMMITTEE ON JUDICIARY STUDY THE FEASIBILITY AND DESIRABILITY OF DIVIDING THE TWELFTH JUDICIAL AND CHANCERY CIRCUIT INTO TWO SEPARATE CIRCUITS, ONE CONSISTING OF CRAWFORD COUNTY AND ONE CONSISTING OF SEBASTIAN COUNTY.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE SEVENTY-SIXTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

That the Joint Rules of the House and Senate are hereby suspended to allow Representatives Blair, Thicksten and Pollan to introduce a bill to request that the Joint Interim Committee on Judiciary study the feasibility and desirability of dividing the Twelfth Judicial and Chancery Circuit into two separate circuits, one consisting of Crawford County and one consisting of Sebastian County.
