

HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

TO SUSPEND THE JOINT RULES OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND SENATE FOR THE PURPOSE OF PERMITTING THE INTRODUCTION OF A HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING HENDRIX COLLEGE FOR ITS PROPOSED PLAN TO PURCHASE MORE OF THE FOOD USED AT THE COLLEGE FROM LOCAL SOURCES AND URGING THE STATE-SUPPORTED UNIVERSITIES AND COLLEGES AND OTHER STATE INSTITUTIONS TO CONSIDER THE FEASIBILITY OF INITIATING SIMILAR PROGRAMS.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE SEVENTY-SIXTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

The Joint Rules of the House of Representatives and Senate are hereby suspended for the purpose of permitting the introduction of a House Joint Resolution commending Hendrix College for its proposed plan to purchase more of the food used at the college from local sources and urging the State-supported universities and colleges and other State institutions to consider the feasibility of initiating similar programs.
