

HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

TO SUSPEND THE JOINT RULES OF THE HOUSE AND THE SENATE TO
ALLOW REPRESENTATIVE WADE TO INTRODUCE A BILL TO LEVY
ADDITIONAL COURT COSTS ON CRIMES AND TRAFFIC OFFENSES
PROSECUTED IN MUNICIPAL COURTS LOCATED IN LITTLE RIVER COUNTY
FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE INCREASED EXPENSES
ANTICIPATED TO RESULT FROM THE RECENTLY ADOPTED AMENDMENT TO
THE ARKANSAS CONSTITUTION WHICH INCREASED THE JURISDICTION OF
MUNICIPAL COURTS.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE SEVENTY-SIXTH GENERAL
ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

That the Joint Rules of the House and the Senate are hereby suspended to
allow Representative Wade to introduce a bill to levy additional court costs
on crimes and traffic offenses prosecuted in municipal courts located in
Little River County for the purpose of defraying the increased expenses anti-
cipated to result from the recently adopted amendment to the Arkansas
Constitution which increased the jurisdiction of municipal courts.
