

HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

TO SUSPEND THE JOINT RULES OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND SENATE FOR THE PURPOSE OF PERMITTING THE INTRODUCTION OF A HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION REQUESTING A STUDY BY THE APPROPRIATE JOINT INTERIM COMMITTEE OF THE DESIRABILITY AND FEASIBILITY OF IMPLEMENTING IN ARKANSAS A GUARANTEED STATE COLLEGE TUITION PROGRAM, PATTERNED AFTER OTHER STATES WHERE SUCH PROGRAMS HAVE BEEN UTILIZED, AND TO REPORT THE FINDINGS OF SAID STUDY TO THE SEVENTY-SEVENTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE SEVENTY-SIXTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

The Joint Rules of the House of Representatives and Senate are hereby suspended for the purpose of permitting the introduction of a House Concurrent Resolution requesting a study by the appropriate joint interim committee of the desirability and feasibility of implementing in Arkansas a guaranteed state college tuition program, patterned after other states where such programs have been utilized, and to report the findings of said study to the Seventy-Seventh General Assembly of the State of Arkansas.
