

HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

TO SUSPEND THE JOINT RULES OF THE HOUSE AND SENATE TO ALLOW REPRESENTATIVE WADE TO INTRODUCE A RESOLUTION URGING THE GOVERNOR TO RESOLVE THE OVERCROWDED CONDITION OF THE STATE PENITENTIARY BY GRANTING EXECUTIVE CLEMENCY TO INMATES WHO ARE RECOMMENDED BY THE STATE BOARD OF PARDONS AND PAROLES AND LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICIALS.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE SEVENTY-SIXTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

That the Joint Rules of the House and Senate are hereby suspended to allow Representative Wade to introduce a resolution urging the Governor to resolved the overcrowded condition of the State Penitentiary by granting executive clemency to inmates who are recommended by the State Board of Pardons and Paroles and law enforcement officials.
