

HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

PROVIDING FOR THE FURTHER EXTENSION OF THE REGULAR SESSION OF THE SEVENTY-SIXTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY UNTIL FRIDAY, APRIL 3, 1987, AT WHICH TIME, UPON COMPLETION OF BUSINESS ON SAID DATE IN EACH HOUSE, THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY SHALL STAND IN RECESS, TO RECONVENE ON MONDAY, APRIL 20, 1987 IF DEEMED NECESSARY TO COMPLETE THE BUSINESS OF THIS SESSION; OTHERWISE, THE SESSION SHALL STAND ADJOURNED SINE DIE ON SAID DATE.

WHEREAS, House Concurrent Resolution 1039 provided for an extension of the Regular Session of the Seventy-Sixth General Assembly until March 27, 1987; and

WHEREAS, it now appears that additional time will be needed to complete the essential business of the Regular Session of the Seventy-Sixth General Assembly,

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE REGULAR SESSION OF THE SEVENTY-SIXTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, AND BY THE SENATE, TWO-THIRDS OF THE MEMBERS ELECTED TO EACH HOUSE AGREEING THERETO:

THAT the regular session of the Seventy-Sixth General Assembly is hereby extended beyond March 27, 1987 until Friday, April 3, 1987, at which time, upon conclusion of business in each house on said date, the regular session of the Seventy-Sixth General Assembly shall stand in recess, to reconvene at 12:00 o'clock Noon on Monday, April 20, 1987, if the Speaker of the House of Representatives and the President Pro Tempore of the Senate shall, by joint proclamation, determine that reconvening of the regular session is necessary to:

- (a) consider executive veto of bills; and/or
- (b) complete action on appropriation bills; and/or
- (c) make further revisions of the Revenue Stabilization Law; and/or
- (d) correct errors in bills; and/or
- (e) complete action on proposed constitutional amendments to be

submitted to the electors of the State at the 1988 general election.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:

THAT if the Speaker of the House of Representatives and the President Pro Tempore of the Senate determine that reconvening of the General Assembly on Monday, April 20, 1987 is not necessary for any of the reasons noted above, then this Resolution shall authorize not less than five members of the House and five members of the Senate to adjourn their respective houses sine die on said date.
