

HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

TO SUSPEND THE JOINT RULES OF THE HOUSE AND THE SENATE TO  
ALLOW REPRESENTATIVE HOGUE TO INTRODUCE A RESOLUTION  
REQUESTING THE JOINT INTERIM COMMITTEE ON AGRICULTURE AND  
ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT TO ESTABLISH A SPECIAL SUBCOMMITTEE ON  
SMALL BUSINESS FOR THE PURPOSE OF IDENTIFYING PROBLEMS  
FACING SMALL BUSINESSES IN ARKANSAS AND IDENTIFYING WAYS IN  
WHICH THE STATE MAY ASSIST IN ADDRESSING THOSE PROBLEMS.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE SEVENTY-SIXTH GENERAL  
ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

That the Joint Rules of the House and the Senate are hereby suspended to  
allow Representative Hogue to introduce a resolution requesting the Joint  
Interim Committee on Agriculture and Economic Development to establish a  
special subcommittee on small business for the purpose of identifying problems  
facing small businesses in Arkansas and identifying ways in which the State  
may assist in addressing those problems.
