

HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

COMMENDING MR. HAROLD RAY JEFFERY OF CALICO ROCK, ARKANSAS,
FOR HIS OUTSTANDING SERVICE AS A GIRLS HIGH SCHOOL BASKETBALL
COACH, FOR HIS MANY YEARS OF SERVICE TO PUBLIC EDUCATION IN
ARKANSAS, AND FOR HIS DEDICATED SERVICE TO HIS COMMUNITY.

WHEREAS, Mr. Harold Ray Jeffery, principal and girls basketball coach at Calico Rock High School, has announced that he will retire from coaching in the near future; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Jeffery served as the girls basketball coach for many years during which time he was honored on several occasions for his outstanding sportsmanship and coaching ability, including his selection as outstanding girls basketball coach in 1974-75-76, and his selection as head coach for the girls all-star game in 1974; and

WHEREAS, during his coaching career, Mr. Jeffery's team won many tournaments and championships including the Overall Girls Championship in 1976, the class "B" Girls State Tournament in 1974-75-76, the Joe T. Robinson Tournament, the Arkansas Tech Tournament, and many others; and

WHEREAS, girls basketball teams coached by Mr. Jeffery won in excess of 1,400 games while losing fewer than 500 games; and

WHEREAS, in honor of Mr. Jeffery's outstanding sportsmanship and coaching ability, the Sportsmanship Award at the Joe T. Robinson Tournament is called the Harold Ray Jeffery Sportsmanship Award; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Jeffery has devoted many years of his life to public education in Arkansas; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Jeffery has not only made significant contributions to public education and been an outstanding basketball coach, he has throughout the years, been a community leader and a tireless worker for worthy civic programs and projects,

NOW THEREFORE,
