

HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

TO SUSPEND THE JOINT RULES OF THE HOUSE AND THE SENATE TO  
ALLOW REPRESENTATIVE HAYS TO INTRODUCE A RESOLUTION  
REQUESTING THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE TO APPOINT A SPECIAL  
COMMITTEE TO WORK WITH THE HOUSE RULES COMMITTEE IN CON-  
DUCTING A COMPREHENSIVE STUDY OF THE PROCEDURES AND RULES  
OF THE HOUSE REGULATING THE INTRODUCTION AND CONSIDERATION  
OF BILLS IN THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE SEVENTY-SIXTH GENERAL  
ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

That the Joint Rules of the House and the Senate are hereby suspended to  
allow Representative Hays to introduce a resolution requesting the Speaker  
of the House to appoint a special committee to work with the House Rules  
Committee in conducting a comprehensive study of the procedures and rules of  
the House regulating the introduction and consideration of bills in the  
House of Representatives.
