HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION

PROPOSING A CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT TO AUTHORIZE THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY TO MEET THE SECOND MONDAY IN JANUARY IN EVEN-NUMBERED YEARS TO CONSIDER BUDGET MATTERS.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, AND BY THE SENATE, A MAJORITY OF ALL THE MEMBERS ELECTED TO EACH HOUSE AGREEING THERETO:

THAT the following is hereby proposed as an amendment to the Constitution of the State of Arkansas, and upon being submitted to the electors of the State for approval or rejection at the next general election for Representatives and Senators, if a majority of the electors voting thereon at such an election adopt such amendment, the same shall become a part of the Constitution of the State of Arkansas, to wit:

"SECTION 1. The General Assembly may, by law, meet on the second Monday in January in even-numbered years solely for the purpose of appropriating funds for the remainder of the fiscal biennium, and the funding thereof, which session may be in addition to the regular biennial session held in odd-numbered years, and shall not exceed thirty (30) days unless by a vote of two-thirds of the members elected to each house of said General Assembly."
