HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION

FOR A PROPOSED CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT TO AUTHORIZE THE
GENERAL ASSEMBLY TO PROVIDE BY LAW FOR THE RECALL OF ELECTED
STATE, COUNTY, DISTRICT, TOWNSHIP, MUNICIPAL AND SCHOOL
DISTRICT OFFICERS, AND OTHER ELECTED PUBLIC OFFICERS.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE SEVENTY-SIXTH
GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS AND BY THE SENATE, A
MAJORITY OF ALL MEMBERS ELECTED TO EACH HOUSE AGREEING THERETO:

That the following is hereby proposed as an amendment to the
Constitution of the State of Arkansas, and upon being submitted to the
electors of the State for approval or rejection at the next general
election for Representatives and Senators, if a majority of the
electors voting thereon at such election, adopt such amendment, the
same shall become a part of the Constitution of the State of Arkansas,
to wit:

SECTION 1. The General Assembly is hereby authorized to provide
for the recall of elected state, county, district, township, municipal
or school district officers or other elected public officers or any or
all of such officers, and to prescribe the procedure for such recall.□
