HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING A STUDY OF FULL-SERVICE AND SELF-SERVICE PRICING
OF GASOLINE AND ITS IMPACT ON HANDICAPPED PERSONS.

WHEREAS, most gasoline stations offer gas at full-service and self-service prices; and

WHEREAS, many handicapped persons are unable to take advantage of self-service gas prices because of their disability and must pay more for gasoline than other persons,

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE SEVENTY-SIXTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

That the Joint Interim Committee on Public Health, Welfare and Labor is requested to study full-service and self-service pricing of gasoline to determine its impact on handicapped persons and to determine whether handicapped persons should be entitled to purchase full-service gasoline at self-service prices.
