HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE JOINT INTERIM COMMITTEE ON AGRICULTURE AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT TO CONTINUE ITS STUDY OF THE ARKANSAS STATE PARKS FOR THE PURPOSE OF MAINTAINING AND IMPROVING PARK FACILITIES, AND ALSO TO STUDY THE DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND TOURISM.

WHEREAS, Arkansas' State parks are an important asset to tourism and are a great source of recreation for the citizens of this State; and

WHEREAS, the State parks must be properly maintained and improved for continued use and enjoyment; and

WHEREAS, as a result of the study of the State parks during the last biennium, it has been determined that the study should not only be continued but should also be broadened to include a review of the Department of Parks and Tourism,

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE SEVENTY-SIXTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

That the Joint Interim Committee on Agriculture and Economic Development not only continue its study of our State parks, but also expand the scope of the study to include a study of the Department of Parks and Tourism.
