HOUSE RESOLUTION

EXPRESSING THE INTENTION OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES TO  
EXPLORE ALL AVENUES AVAILABLE FOR FINANCING THE OPERATION OF  
STATE GOVERNMENT.

WHEREAS, the House of Representatives takes notice that not only are tax revenues currently insufficient to fund the operation of State Government as it should be, but that the demand for state services increases; and

WHEREAS, in order to provide the services requested by the citizens of this state, it is necessary to generate enough revenues to pay for these services; and

WHEREAS, the House of Representatives does not intend to act on this issue without giving full consideration to all the alternatives for generating additional revenues.

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE SEVENTY-SIXTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

That it is the intention of this body to investigate every alternative method of generating additional revenues to provide for the delivery of the services demanded by the people.
