HOUSE RESOLUTION

CALLING UPON THE UNITED STATES CONGRESS TO TAKE ACTION TO  
STEM THE SWELLING TIDE OF MAIL FRAUD IN THIS COUNTRY.

WHEREAS, fraud perpetrated through the United States mail has increased in recent years at a frightening rate; and

WHEREAS, the Arkansas Attorney General's office receives hundreds of complaints each month from citizens of this State who have been gypped as a result of mail fraud; and

WHEREAS, there is no efficient and effective means for the states to address this problem; and

WHEREAS, it is incumbent upon the Congress of the United States to assure that the United States postal system is adequately policed in order to minimize unlawful activities carried on through the United States mail,

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE SEVENTY-SIXTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

That the Congress of the United States is hereby requested to strengthen the enforcement of the laws relating to the uses of the United States mail and to take such action deemed necessary to stop the epidemic of mail fraud presently occurring in this country.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted to each member of Arkansas' Congressional delegation.
