

HOUSE RESOLUTION

TO AMEND HOUSE RULE 26 (a) TO PROVIDE THAT WHEN A PROPOSITION HAS BEEN MADE AND CARRIED OR LOST, IT SHALL BE IN ORDER FOR ANY MEMBER OF THE MAJORITY ON THE SAME OR SUCCEEDING DAY TO MOVE FOR THE RECONSIDERATION THEREOF, OR GIVE NOTICE OF HIS INTENTIONS TO DO SO AND SUCH MOTION SHALL TAKE PRECEDENCE OVER OTHER QUESTIONS EXCEPT CONSIDERATION OF A CONFERENCE REPORT OR A MOTION TO ADJOURN: PROVIDED, THE MOTION OR PROPOSITION SHALL ONLY BE CONSIDERED DURING THE PERIOD RESERVED FOR REGULAR BILLS.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE SEVENTY-SIXTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

That subsection (a) of Rule 26 of the House of Representatives is hereby amended to read as follows:

"(a) When a proposition has been made and carried or lost, it shall be in order for any member of the majority on the same or succeeding day to move for the reconsideration thereof, or give notice of his intentions to do so and such motion shall take precedence over other questions except consideration of a conference report or a motion to adjourn: Provided, the motion or proposition shall only be considered during the period reserved for regular bills. The notice shall not be withdrawn after the said succeeding day without the consent of the House, and thereafter any member may call it up for consideration: Provided, the notice to reconsider must be disposed of within three (3) days from the time the vote was taken, which it is sought to have reconsidered; provided, that such notice to reconsider cannot be given after the fifty-fourth (54th) day of a regular session or during a special session, during which times the motion to reconsider must be disposed of immediately."
