SENATE BILL 127

"AN ACT TO ESTABLISH MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS FOR THE OFFICE  
OF ATTORNEY GENERAL; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. In order to hold the office of Attorney General, a person must be a citizen of the United States, at least thirty (30) years of age, of good moral character, a resident of the State for at least two (2) years, learned in the law, and an attorney at law in good standing and shall have practiced law at least six (6) years.

SECTION 2. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
