SENATE BILL 182

"AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE STATE BOARD OF COSMETOLOGY TO ACCEPT PERSONAL OR BUSINESS CHECKS IN PAYMENT OF FEES COLLECTED BY THE BOARD; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. In addition to any other method of payment acceptable to the State Board of Cosmetology, the Board shall accept personal or business checks drawn on deposit accounts in financial institutions as payment for fees collected by the Board.

SECTION 2. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. Emergency. It is hereby found and determined by the General Assembly that the State Board of Cosmetology does not accept personal checks or business checks as payment for its fees, but instead requires that payment be made by certified checks, money orders, cashiers checks or similar instruments; that this results in unnecessary expense and aggravation to persons required to pay fees collected by the Board; and that this Act eliminates such unnecessary expense and aggravation. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
