SENATE BILL 235

"AN ACT DESIGNATING BREAM AS THE OFFICIAL FISH OF THE STATE
OF ARKANSAS."

WHEREAS, the lakes and streams of Arkansas are legendary in fishermen folklore for their contents of bream; and

WHEREAS, the bream has developed a reputation as the best tasting fish to fry in a pan having a flesh of texture incomparable to any other fish; and

WHEREAS, sportsmen from far and wide annually flock to Arkansas to challenge the fish that has become known as the fightingest fish ounce for ounce.

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. That the bream is hereby designated as the official fish of the State of Arkansas.

SECTION 2. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
