SENATE BILL 249

"AN ACT ESTABLISHING THE SALARY AND EXPENSE ALLOWANCE OF THE DEPUTY PROSECUTING ATTORNEY FOR RANDOLPH COUNTY; TO ESTABLISH THE PORTION OF THE THIRD CIRCUIT PROSECUTING ATTORNEY'S EXPENSE ALLOWANCE PAID BY RANDOLPH COUNTY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Randolph County shall pay the prosecuting attorney of the Third Circuit-Chancery Court Circuit an annual expense allowance of \$2,400.00.

SECTION 2. The annual salary for the deputy prosecuting attorney for Randolph County shall be \$11,000.00 to be paid by the county. The Randolph County Deputy Prosecuting Attorney shall receive an annual expense allowance of \$3,000.00 to be paid by the county.

SECTION 3. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
