SENATE BILL 29

"AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL TO EMPLOY SPECIAL
COUNSEL TO INTERVENE ON BEHALF OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY IN
LAWSUITS OF IMPORTANCE TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY; AND FOR OTHER
PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. The Legislative Council may contract with attorneys of its choice to represent the interests of the General Assembly by intervening in lawsuits which the Council determines to be of importance to the General Assembly.

SECTION 2. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.
