SENATE BILL 362

"AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 2 OF ACT 764 OF 1985 [ARK. STAT. ANN. □5-1125], TO CLARIFY THE DEFINITION OF A MISSING CHILD; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Section 2 of Act 764 of 1985, the same being Ark. Stat. Ann. □5-1125, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 2. (1) 'Missing Child' means any person who is under the age of eighteen (18) years, whose residence is in Arkansas or is believed to be in Arkansas, whose location is unknown or who has been the victim of interference with custody as defined by Ark. Stat. Ann. □41-2416(a), and who has been reported as missing to a law enforcement agency.

(2) 'Missing Child report' is a report prepared on a form designated by the Arkansas Crime Information Center for use by law enforcement agencies to record missing children information."

SECTION 2. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
