SENATE BILL 471

"AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 1 OF ACT 138 OF 1973, AS AMENDED, TO PROVIDE FOR THE PAYMENT OF FUNERAL BENEFITS UNDER REQUIRED FIRST PARTY COVERAGE OF PERSONAL AUTOMOBILE LIABILITY INSURANCE POLICIES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Section 1(a) of of Act 138 of 1973, as amended, the same being Arkansas Statutes Annotated §66-4014(1)(a), is hereby amended to read as follows:

"(a) MEDICAL AND HOSPITAL BENEFITS. All reasonable and necessary expenses for medical, hospital, nursing, dental, surgical, ambulance, funeral expenses, and prosthetic services incurred within twenty-four (24) months after the automobile accident, up to an aggregate of five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00) per person and may include any non-medical remedial care and treatment rendered in accordance with a recognized religious method of healing. Expenses for hospital room charges may be limited to semiprivate accommodations."

SECTION 2. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
