SENATE BILL 477

"AN ACT TO ALLOW THE DIVISION OF LEGISLATIVE AUDIT TO PAY STATE EMPLOYEES FOR SERVICES RENDERED IN CONDUCTING CONTINUING PROFESSIONAL EDUCATION COURSES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. FEES FOR CONTINUING PROFESSIONAL EDUCATION INSTRUCTORS. The Division of Legislative Audit is authorized to contract and pay part-time or full-time employees of other state agencies for services rendered in conducting continuing professional education courses for the staff of the Division of Legislative Audit.

SECTION 2. EMERGENCY. It is hereby found and determined by the General Assembly that continuing professional education for the staff of the Division of Legislative Audit is vital to efficient governmental operations. It is also found and determined by the General Assembly that employees of other state agencies, in particular state supported colleges and universities, can provide such continuing professional education for the staff of the Division of Legislative Audit at considerable savings to the State of Arkansas. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
