SENATE BILL 530

"AN ACT TO MAKE IT UNLAWFUL TO FRAUDULENTLY SOLICIT MONEY OR
PROPERTY FROM AN INCOMPETENT PERSON; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. (a) It shall be unlawful for any person to solicit money or property from a person he knows or should have reason to know is an incompetent person or is a person with diminished mental capacity, and to cause that incompetent person or person with diminished mental capacity to voluntarily surrender money or property in order to profit or secure gain by taking unfair advantage of the person's incompetency or diminished mental capacity.

(b) Any person violating the provisions of this Act shall be guilty of a Class D felony.

SECTION 2. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
