SENATE BILL 54

"AN ACT TO REPEAL ACT 276 OF 1975 AS AMENDED, [ARK. STATS.
75-1013.1] RELATING TO THE AUTHORITY AND RESPONSIBILITY OF
THE OFFICE OF DRIVERS' SERVICES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE
AND ADMINISTRATION TO KEEP AND FURNISH COPIES OF RECORDS OF
MOTOR VEHICLE OPERATOR AND CHAUFFEUR TRAFFIC VIOLATIONS; AND
FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Act 276 of 1975, as amended, the same being Arkansas Statutes 75-1013.1, is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. EMERGENCY. It is hereby found and determined by the General Assembly that Act 276 of 1975, as amended, prohibits the Office of Drivers' Services of the Department of Finance and Administration from including certain traffic violations in traffic violation reports and requires it to produce different records and reports based on whether a licensee has a chauffeur's or operator's license and whether a chauffeur is a prospective employee or current employee; that it is in the interest of highway safety that said Act be repealed so the Office of Drivers' Services can compile and furnish reports of all convictions on traffic violation records of all licensees; and that it is urgent that this Act be given effect immediately to accomplish this desirable purpose. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
