SENATE BILL 614

"AN ACT TO PERMIT ANY PERSON WHO HAS A SERIOUS WALKING
HANDICAP TO OPERATE A THREE OR FOUR WHEELED ALL-TERRAIN
VEHICLE AS A MEANS OF TRANSPORTATION UPON NON-HARD SURFACED
ROADS IN THE STATE AND UPON THE RIGHTS-OF-WAY OF CERTAIN
OTHER ROADS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Any person who has lost one or both legs above the ankle or who otherwise has a serious walking handicap shall be permitted to operate a three or four wheeled all-terrain vehicle as a means of transportation upon any non-hard surfaced road in the State and upon the rights-of-way of all State and federal highways other than the rights-of-way of the Federal Interstate Highway System.

SECTION 2. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
