SENATE BILL 620

"AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 1 OF ACT 267 OF 1953 [ARK. STATS.
43-2327] TO AUTHORIZE THE COURT IN WHICH PERSONS ARE
CONVICTED OF CERTAIN OFFENSES INVOLVING DEADLY WEAPONS TO
CONFISCATE SUCH WEAPONS AND TRANSFER SUCH WEAPONS AND THE
TITLE THERETO TO LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES IF SUCH WEAPONS ARE
SUITABLE FOR USE BY SUCH AGENCIES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Section 1 of Act 267 of 1953, the same being Arkansas
Statutes 43-2327, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 1. When any person is convicted of any homicide, burglary, robbery,
assault with intent to kill, assault with a deadly weapon, battery or
any other felony involving a deadly weapon the court in which the person is
convicted may confiscate the deadly weapons involved in the offense and may by
court order either transfer such weapons and the title thereto to an
appropriate state or local law enforcement agency or if such weapons are not
suitable for use by law enforcement agencies may order the weapons destroyed."

SECTION 2. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are
hereby repealed.
