SENATE BILL 659

"AN ACT TO CREATE THE SEPARATE OFFICES OF SHERIFF AND TAX  
COLLECTOR IN CLEBURNE COUNTY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Effective January 1, 1989, the offices of sheriff and tax collector in Cleburne County shall be separate offices. At the 1988 general election, the electors of Cleburne County shall elect a sheriff and a tax collector and each officer so elected shall take office on January 1, 1989. The sheriff and tax collector in Cleburne County shall each give bond for the faithful performance of their duties as is now or hereafter provided by law.

SECTION 2. The sheriff and the collector of Cleburne County shall each receive such compensation as shall be determined by the quorum court of Cleburne County within the minimum and maximum compensation range prescribed by the General Assembly, and such other deputy hire and other allowances as shall be prescribed by the quorum court.

SECTION 3. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
