"AN ACT TO PROHIBIT ATTORNEYS FROM USING THE PRINTED OR  
BROADCAST MEDIA, CABLE TV OR ANY OTHER MEDIUM TO DIRECTLY  
SOLICIT CLIENTS OR ENCOURAGE LITIGATION; AND FOR OTHER  
PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. No attorney shall use the printed media or broadcast media, cable television or any other medium to directly solicit clients or encourage litigation in this State. Attorneys may utilize the media and all other mediums for advertising their areas of practice or expertise, fees, address, telephone number, and as otherwise permitted by the Arkansas Supreme Court.

SECTION 2. Violations of this Act shall constitute class A misdemeanors.

SECTION 3. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
