SENATE BILL 85

"AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT SOCIAL SECURITY RECIPIENTS SHALL NOT BE PENALIZED FOR LATE PAYMENT OF UTILITY BILLS IF THEY MAKE PAYMENT NO LATER THAN THE THIRD BUSINESS DAY OF THE MONTH; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. When any utility consumer furnishes proof to a utility that the consumer is a Social Security recipient, the consumer's utility payment shall not be considered past due if the consumer pays or mails payment no later than the third day (excluding Saturday, Sunday and holidays) of the month following the billing.

SECTION 2. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
