SENATE BILL 9

"AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR CONSTRUCTING AND EQUIPPING THE SOUTH ARKANSAS RADIATION THERAPY INSTITUTE IN EL DORADO, ARKANSAS; AND THE W. TEMPLE WEBBER RADIATION THERAPY INSTITUTE IN TEXARKANA, ARKANSAS"; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for constructing and equipping the South Arkansas Radiation Therapy Institute in El Dorado, Arkansas, and the W. Temple Webber Radiation Therapy Institute in Texarkana, Arkansas, the sum of\$1,000,000 each.

SECTION 2. The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall be the disbursing officer for funds authorized in Section 1 of this Act and shall make such reasonable rules and regulations as he deems necessary in carrying out the provisions of this Act.

SECTION 3. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the Seventy-Sixth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1987 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 1987 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1987.
