

SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

PROVIDING FOR A JOINT SESSION OF THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE SEVENTY-SIXTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY AT 10:00 A.M. ON TUESDAY, JANUARY 13, 1987, FOR THE PURPOSE OF CANVASSING THE RESULTS OF THE ELECTION OF THE STATE'S CONSTITUTIONAL OFFICERS, AND FOR THE PURPOSE OF ADMINISTERING THE OATH OF OFFICE AND HEARING AN ADDRESS BY GOVERNOR BILL CLINTON.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE SEVENTY-SIXTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT the Senate and House of Representatives shall meet in joint session in the House Chamber, State Capitol Building, at 10:00 a.m. on Tuesday, January 13, 1987, for the purpose of canvassing the results of the election of the State's constitutional officers, and for the purpose of administering the oath of office and hearing an address by Governor Bill Clinton.
