

SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

PETITIONING CONGRESS TO REINTRODUCE AND PASS THE FEDERAL MAIL ORDER SALES TAX BILL.

WHEREAS, Arkansas, as well as other states, have difficulty collecting tax resulting from mail order sales, and

WHEREAS, as a result the states are losing a substantial amount of revenues which are desparately needed to provide necessary services to the people; and

WHEREAS, the Federal Mail Order Sales Tax Bill would grant needed relief to the states,

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE SEVENTY-SIXTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:

That the Congress of the United States is hereby respectfully requested to reintroduce and enact the Federal Mail Order Sales Tax Bill.
