

SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION  
DESIGNATING THE WEEK OF APRIL 5 THROUGH APRIL 11, 1987 AS  
SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY WEEK IN ARKANSAS.

WHEREAS, the week of April 5 through April 11, 1987 has been designated National Science and Technology Week; and

WHEREAS, during this time the nation's attention is focused on the importance of science and technology; and

WHEREAS, it is important to recognize the essential roles of science and technology in our society and particularly in this State; and

WHEREAS, science and technology provide knowledge and products directly related to our economy, our health, our defense and ultimately our quality of life; and

WHEREAS, the State of Arkansas has increasingly emphasized science and technology in recent years,

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE SEVENTY-SIXTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:

That the week of April 5 through April 11, 1987 is hereby designated and recognized as "Science and Technology Week" in Arkansas.
