

SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

TO SUSPEND THE JOINT RULES OF THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES TO PERMIT THE INTRODUCTION AND CONSIDERATION OF A BILL SPONSORED BY SENATOR MALONE TO ESTABLISH AS VIOLATIONS OF LAW CERTAIN CONDUCT INVOLVING THE USE OF COMPUTERS.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE SEVENTY-SIXTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:

That the Joint Rules of the Senate and the House of Representatives are hereby suspended for the purpose of permitting the introduction and consideration of a bill by Senator Malone to establish as violations of law certain conduct involving the use of computers.
