

SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION
PROVIDING FOR THE SUSPENSION OF THE JOINT RULES OF THE
SENATE AND HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, FOR THE PURPOSE OF
AUTHORIZING THE INTRODUCTION OF A BILL TO AMEND THE
PRESENT LAW TO AUTHORIZE CITIES WITH POPULATIONS OF OVER
70,000 CITIZENS TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL SICK LEAVE OPTIONS
FOR FIRE FIGHTERS.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE REGULAR SESSION OF THE SEVENTY-SIXTH
GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, AND BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
CONCURRING THEREIN, TWO-THIRDS OF THE MEMBERS OF BOTH HOUSES AGREEING THERETO:

THAT the Joint Rules of the Senate and House of Representatives are
hereby suspended for the purpose of authorizing the introduction and con-
sideration of a bill to amend Section 1 of Act 393 of 1969, as amended (Ark.
Stat. 19-1718), to authorize cities with a population of over 70,000 citizens
to provide additional sick leave options for fire fighters.
