

SENATE RESOLUTION

DESIGNATING FEBRUARY 17, 1987, AS STATE FEDERATION OF DEMOCRATIC WOMEN'S DAY AND COMMENDING THE FEDERATION AND SHEILA BELL OF VAN BUREN, PRESIDENT OF THE FEDERATION, FOR THEIR OUTSTANDING CONTRIBUTIONS TO GOOD GOVERNMENT.
