

SENATE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE APPROPRIATE PROSECUTING ATTORNEYS TO INSTITUTE
REMOVAL PROCEEDINGS AGAINST GAME AND FISH COMMISSIONERS WHO
HAVE FAILED TO FILE CODE OF ETHICS STATEMENTS AS REQUIRED BY
LAW.

WHEREAS, Act 570 of 1979 requires Game and Fish Commissioners to file
a Code of Ethics statement with the Secretary of State; and

WHEREAS, certain Game and Fish Commission members have apparently not
complied with that law; and

WHEREAS, Act 570 of 1979 provides that any person who willfully conceals
or fails to disclose any information required by that Act is guilty of
malfeasance in office and shall be removed therefrom; and

WHEREAS, Act 570 of 1979 places the duty upon the prosecuting attorneys
of this State to enforce that Act,

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE SEVENTY-SIXTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE
STATE OF ARKANSAS:

That the several prosecuting attorneys of this State are hereby requested
to institute proceedings for the removal of Game and Fish Commissioners within
their jurisdictions who have failed to file within the past two years their
code of ethics statements as required by Act 570 of 1979.
