WHEREAS, the Pine Bluff High School Zebra Baseball Team has won four consecutive State championships in Class AAA, the largest division; and

WHEREAS, the current members of the team have compiled outstanding records of twenty-one wins and one loss in 1985 and twenty-seven wins and one loss in 1986; and
