

SENATE RESOLUTION

TO ESTABLISH A SENATE COMMITTEE ON RETIREMENT, WHICH SHALL BE  
A STANDING COMMITTEE AND WHICH SHALL REVIEW ALL BILLS  
COMING BEFORE THE SENATE RELATING TO PUBLIC SUPPORTED  
RETIREMENT SYSTEMS.

WHEREAS, many bills are filed at each regular session of the General Assembly dealing with various aspects of the several public supported retirement systems in the State; and

WHEREAS, public retirement legislation has become so complex and far reaching in scope that every such bill should be thoroughly studied before being acted upon by the Senate,

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE SEVENTY-SIXTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

There is hereby created the Senate Committee on Retirement which shall be a standing committee of the Senate to be composed of the Senate members of the Joint Committee on Social Security and Retirement, the Senate Chairman of the Joint Budget Committee and the Chairman of the Senate Select Committee on Rules, Resolutions and Memorials.

The Senate Retirement Committee created by this Resolution shall review and analyze each and every bill coming before the Senate relating to the various public supported retirement systems.
