

SENATE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE ARKANSAS INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION TO EXPLORE  
POTENTIAL EXPANSION OF DEVELOPMENT AND TRADE WITH SUB-SAHARA AFRICA

WHEREAS, Sub-Sahara Africa is mainly underdeveloped but is a land with  
rich potential; and

WHEREAS, a need exists to supply agricultural and industrial products to  
countries in Sub-Sahara Africa; and

WHEREAS, the atmosphere and attitude of the countries in Sub-Sahara  
Africa is very receptive to expansion of trade with producers in the United  
States; and

WHEREAS, Arkansas producers of agricultural and industrial products have  
the potential to supply many of the products needed in Sub-Sahara Africa,

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE SEVENTY-SIXTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE  
STATE OF ARKANSAS,

That the Senate request the Arkansas Industrial Development Commission to  
explore potential expansion of development and trade with countries in  
Sub-Sahara Africa.
