

SENATE RESOLUTION

PROVIDING FOR THE REFERRAL TO THE JOINT BUDGET COMMITTEE OF ALL BILLS THAT WILL INCREASE THE COST OF THE PUBLICLY-SUPPORTED RETIREMENT SYSTEMS OF THIS STATE WHICH RECEIVE A FAVORABLE RECOMMENDATION FROM THE JOINT COMMITTEE ON PUBLIC RETIREMENT AND SOCIAL SECURITY PROGRAMS.

WHEREAS, a number of bills reported out of the Joint Committee on Public Retirement and Social Security Programs with a "do pass" recommendation will have a fiscal impact on the cost of the State-supported retirement systems, and such fiscal impact should be reviewed by the Joint Budget Committee before the bills are considered on the floor of the Senate,

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE REGULAR SESSION OF THE SEVENTY-SIXTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

THAT all retirement bills which receive a "do pass" recommendation from the Joint Committee on Public Retirement and Social Security Programs, which will increase the cost of a State-supported retirement system, shall be re-referred to the Joint Budget Committee for its review and recommendations before the same are presented to the Senate for third reading and final passage.
