HOUSE BILL 1001

"AN ACT TO MAKE A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION FOR THE
ARKANSAS HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES FOR THE FIRST
EXTRAORDINARY SESSION OF THE SEVENTY SIXTH GENERAL
ASSEMBLY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated, to be payable from the Constitutional and Fiscal Agencies Fund, to the Arkansas House of Representatives for additional personal services, operating expenses, per diem and mileage which shall be supplemental and in addition to those funds provided under Act 1 of 1987, the sum of\$100,000.00

SECTION 2. In the event that the Speaker of the House of Representatives and the Coordinator of Legislative Services determine that there are insufficient funds or appropriations, or both, available to provide the services to the House of Representatives as contemplated under the appropriation provided by any Section of Act 1 of 1987, then they shall notify the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State to transfer such appropriation and funds, in such amount(s) as they deem to be needed, from the appropriation and funds available under Section 1 of Act 1 of 1987 to any other appropriation made by Act 1 of 1987.

SECTION 3. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the Seventy-Sixth General Assembly, meeting in Extraordinary Session, that the appropriation for the Arkansas House of Representatives as provided by Act 1 of 1987 did not anticipate the convening by the Governor of an extraordinary session and that additional appropriation must be provided to defray such additional costs as may be incurred. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
