"AN ACT TO AMEND ACT 187 OF 1987 (STATE DIVISION EARLY RETIREMENT INCENTIVE ACT) AND ACT 717 OF 1987 (COUNTY DIVISION EARLY RETIREMENT INCENTIVE ACT) TO PERMIT ELECTED OFFICIALS TO SERVE OUT THEIR ELECTED TERM PRIOR TO RETIREMENT UNDER THE INCENTIVES, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Section 9 of Act 187 of 1987 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 9. (A) No position being vacated as a result of an employee retiring pursuant to the provisions of this Act shall be filled without the written approval of the Governor or the Chief Fiscal Officer.

(B) For those State Elected Constitutional Officers and Members of the General Assembly who, as a member of the State Division of the Public Employees Retirement System, would qualify by meeting all those requirements set forth above to retire under the early retirement incentives set forth herein by January 1, 1988, the time period in which they may elect to retire hereunder shall be extended to the last day of their current term for which they are serving."

SECTION 2. Section 4 of Act 717 of 1987 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 4. (A) No position being vacated as a result of a county employee retiring pursuant to the provisions of this Act shall be filled without the approval by resolution of the quorum court.

(B) For those County Elected Constitutional Officers who, as a member of the County Division of the Public Employees Retirement System, would qualify by meeting all those requirements set forth above to retire under the early

retirement incentives set forth herein by January 1, 1988, the time period in which they may elect to retire hereunder shall be extended to the last day of their current term for which they are serving."

SECTION 3. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
