HOUSE BILL 1042

"AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION TO DEFRAY THE EXPENSES OF MOVING THE COLLECTION OF THE FRANCHISE TAX TO THE OFFICE OF THE SECRETARY OF STATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby appropriated to the Secretary of State, to be payable from the Constitutional and Fiscal Agencies Fund to defray the expense of relocation of the franchise tax collection to the Office of the Secretary of State for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1988, the following:

SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the Secretary of State, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: Three (3) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, for the appropriate classification.

SECTION 3. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the Seventy-Sixth General Assembly meeting in 1st Extraordinary Session that Act 19 of 1987 transferred the responsibility for collecting the franchise tax from the Department of Finance and Administration to the Office of the

Secretary of State, that there will be expenses for filing, rewiring and renovation and temporary employees required to defray the cost of moving this responsibility. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1987.
