

"AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION TO IMPLEMENT THE CENTRAL FARM FILING SYSTEM; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Secretary of State, to be payable from the Constitutional and Fiscal Agencies Fund for personal services and operating expenses of the Central Farm Filing System in the Office of the Secretary of State for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1988, the following:

SECTION 2. Positions authorized in Section 1 of Act 108 of 1987 shall be payable from Section 3 of this Act until sufficient fees are collected to allow the Office of Secretary of State to finance the Central Farm Filing

System as authorized in Act 108 of 1987.

SECTION 3. FUNDING PROVISION. Of proceeds generated from the Central Farm Filing System, reimbursement of expenditures as authorized by Section 3 of this Act shall be made by the Office of the Secretary of State to the State Central Services Fund during the 1987-89 Biennium. Such reimbursement shall follow procedures promulgated by the Chief Fiscal Officer.

SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the Seventy-Sixth General Assembly meeting in 1st Extraordinary Session that insufficient fee collections require advanced funding for the Central Farm Filing System to defray start-up expenses. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1987.
