"AN ACT TO ESTABLISH THE SALARY OF THE SECRETARY-CASE COORDINATOR FOR THE CIRCUIT-CHANCERY JUDGESHIP OF THE EIGHTEENTH JUDICIAL CIRCUIT - EAST; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. On and after January 1, 1989, the Circuit-Chancery Judge for the Eighteenth Judicial Circuit-East, may employ a secretary-case coordinator to serve at the pleasure of the Judge, at the same annual salary of the secretary-case coordinators serving the Circuit Court and the Chancery Court of the Eighteenth Judicial Circuit-East.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined by the General Assembly that on January 1, 1989, a Circuit-Chancery Judge for the Eighteenth Judicial Circuit-East will assume office. That the function of a secretary-case coordinator is necessary for the proper administration of justice and the effectiveness of the judgeship. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall be in effect from the date of its passage and approval.
